ENHANCED *Language* TRAINING

Learners advance their communication skills for the workplace.

Construction Technologies Training or Light Industrial Training

- 5 weeks of industry specific language training
- 9 weeks of Construction Technologies Training or 8 weeks Light Industrial Training
