

Prep for High School (Literacy/Numeracy) Program at JP II

- Open to Gr. 7 & Gr. 8 Students
- Select 10 day or 20 day classes
- This is a non-credit program designed to help Gr 7/8 students prepare for high school Math & English.

* Reach Ahead Credits (110 hours) at J.P. II or via Internet

Grade 8 students can reach ahead (in courses marked with an asterisk *) to grade 9 or grade 10 new credit on-site or on-line courses that have no prerequisite.

On-line Intermediate Courses

Students can select courses to do at their home. Preference will be given to students not able to attend JP II because of distance or summer job.

Special Information for On-line Courses

- Students need Internet access (high speed is preferred but dial-up is acceptable) and a reliable computer.
- Students can access their learning at any time but must keep up with the class and finish on or before July 28th. Students new to e-Learning must attend an Orientation session to prepare them for the course.
- Students must accept the LDCSB's e-Learning contract which expects appropriate behaviour on-line.
