Enhanced language program for Construction Technology Training

Program aim:

If you want to get construction technology training, this program is for you. The program works closely with the Pathways Skill Development Centre to ensure that after the training, you will be fully ready to be employed in the construction industry.

Class schedule

The program starts with 5 weeks of enhanced language training during which you will improve your general language proficiency and to learn trade specific language. Classes will be run Monday to Friday 6 hours daily (9 am – 3 pm). After the language training, you are ready to move onto the skills training. For 8 weeks, you will learn basic building techniques so that you are ready to work in home or commercial construction and renovation assisting framers, plumbers, roofers, electricians etc. In week 9 you will be placed with local employers to get on the job experience. After the placement, Pathways will continue to work with you for employment training and employment connection and to provide job mentoring and employment monitoring.

Requirements to enter the program

You must be at a minimum Canadian benchmarks ESL level 5+, be 18 years or older, and staying in Canada as a landed immigrant or conventional refugee. ***There is no charge for the training if you meet these criteria.***
