Specialized language training for Food and Beverage Service Occupations

Program aim:

If you are interested in working in the food and beverage service industry, this program is for you. The program works closely with the London Training Centre to ensure that after the training, you will be fully ready to be employed in the food and beverage service industry.

Class schedule

Classes will be run Monday to Friday 5 hours daily for 10 weeks. You will attend classes at the Centre for the first 5 weeks. You will practice language you need to communicate professionally in the fast-moving restaurant and catering industry in your role either as cooks, bartenders or waiters or waitresses. You will also receive training in workplace safety (WHMIS). Then for the remaining 5 weeks you will attend classes at the London Training Centre. There you will get hands on skills training in areas such as fast food and counter service, point of sale and cash register training, safe food handling, beverage and alcohol service training using the *SmartServe* program recognized by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.

Throughout the course you will receive job search training and the London Training Centre will help you to find jobs related to the program. The Centre for Lifelong Learning has also established a good relationship with the hospitality service at King's University College at the University of Western Ontario, where the manager has been hiring a number of our graduates to fill vacancies.

Certification

By passing the examination in the different components of your training, you will get:

WHMIS Certification

Safe Food Handler Certification (recognized by all health units in Ontario)

SmartServe Certification

Requirements to enter the program

You must be at a Canadian benchmarks ESL level 5 - 8, be 18 years or older and have legal status staying in Canada. *There is no charge for the training if you meet these criteria.*
