

## On-line Senior Courses

Students can select a course to do at their home. Preference will be given to students not able to attend CCH because of distance or summer job. All senior courses require the student to sit an in-person written exam either at CCH or, with an appropriate reason, a proctored exam at another location.

## Special Information for On-line Courses

- Students need Internet access (high speed is preferred but dial-up is acceptable) and a reliable computer.
- Students can access their learning at any time but must keep up with the class and finish on or before July 28th.
- Students new to e-Learning must attend an Orientation session to prepare them for the course.
- For courses with final exams, students must attend a written exam at CCH (or a proctored exam at another site) on Thursday July 28, 2011.
- Students must accept the LDCSB's e-Learning contract which expects appropriate behaviour on-line.
